Stock Tank Essential Oil Spa

For my stock tank spa I used 1/2 inch Pex which is used in my house for the hot and cold water.

We ran the water from a new connection out the wall and to the tank. Yes I put holes in my wall...

Place it in a corner to create a private oasis. Add some fake trees for extra privacy! Add oils and enjoy.

Materials List- I did not do this alone! I got a handy friend with some tools to shop with me and install it.

Shark Bite Pex valve (to connect your current water source to your new tub)- 2 @ \$12 each =\$24



Pex 10 foot lengths or roll depending on your distance - \$5 each (I used 3 red and 3 blue)= \$30

SharkBite Pex copper rings (25 pack- you will need 2 at each connection)- \$10 = \$10



SharkBite Pex Couplings in straight or elbow (One at each connection- I used 8-10)- \$2 each = \$20



SharkBite Pex Faucet- 2 @ \$12 = \$24



Smooth Sided Stock Tank (I used 180 Gal) - Avg \$160



The total of the listed items is \$268- Leave room for some extra stuff! You will need to secure the Pex to walls or under decks. We used plastic holds we had here with some screws. But this will get you most of the way!!
